- CPMR has worked to outline the proposals to fight plastic pollution and marine litter, and promote Regions' views in European Commission debates
- <u>Declaration</u> presented by North Sea Commission's President and adopted by the <u>CPMR Political Bureau</u> in June 2018
- SUD Region (France) represented CPMR in debates on plastic & marine litter, organised by SEARICA in 2018
- Beach cleaning exercise in Fredrikstad (Norway) and Madeira (Portugal) at the CPMR General Assembly



CPMR supports cooperation between its Member Regions and public-private organisations, involving the development of European cooperation projects.

Together with our Geographical Commissions we are involved in:

- <u>CleanAtlantic</u> Project, aiming to improve monitoring, prevent and remove macro marine litter
 - <u>PANACeA</u> Project aiming to improve management of protected areas in the Mediterranean



- Together with our Geographical Commissions we are involved in:
 - <u>MEDSEALITTER</u> Project aimed at developing specific marine litter monitoring protocols
 - <u>CO-EVOLVE</u> Project promoting the co-evolution of human activities and natural system for the development of sustainable coastal and maritime tourism

The <u>Bologna Charter Initiative</u> and the CO-EVOLVE Project were presented at the <u>BSEC-CPMR Workshop on Project</u> <u>Promotion</u>, in March 2018, as <u>sources of inspiration for the</u> <u>Black Sea region</u>.
