The ICBSS at the 4th AgriBusiness Forum 2021 (Athens, Greece)

Minister for Development & Investments), Mr. Cottogni (Dpt. Director, European Investment Fund), the leadership of the Ministry of Rural Development & Food etc;
- 4) the participation as official partners of the United Nations agencies, being FAO & UN Women;
- 5) the origin of the panelists, being 65% from Greece, 35% from abroad (out of them 40% women);
- 6) the leading audience from businesses (50%), farmers (15%), academia (20%) and policy makers (15%);
- 7) the 20-hours conference livestreaming flow;
- 8) the exhibition areas boosting sponsors outreach both onsite and virtually.

Being evident, credible, relevant and transparent across businesses, farmers, academia and policy makers, AgriBusiness Forum sharpens the saw towards viable, sustainable, traceable and resilient agrifood systems in Greece and beyond.
