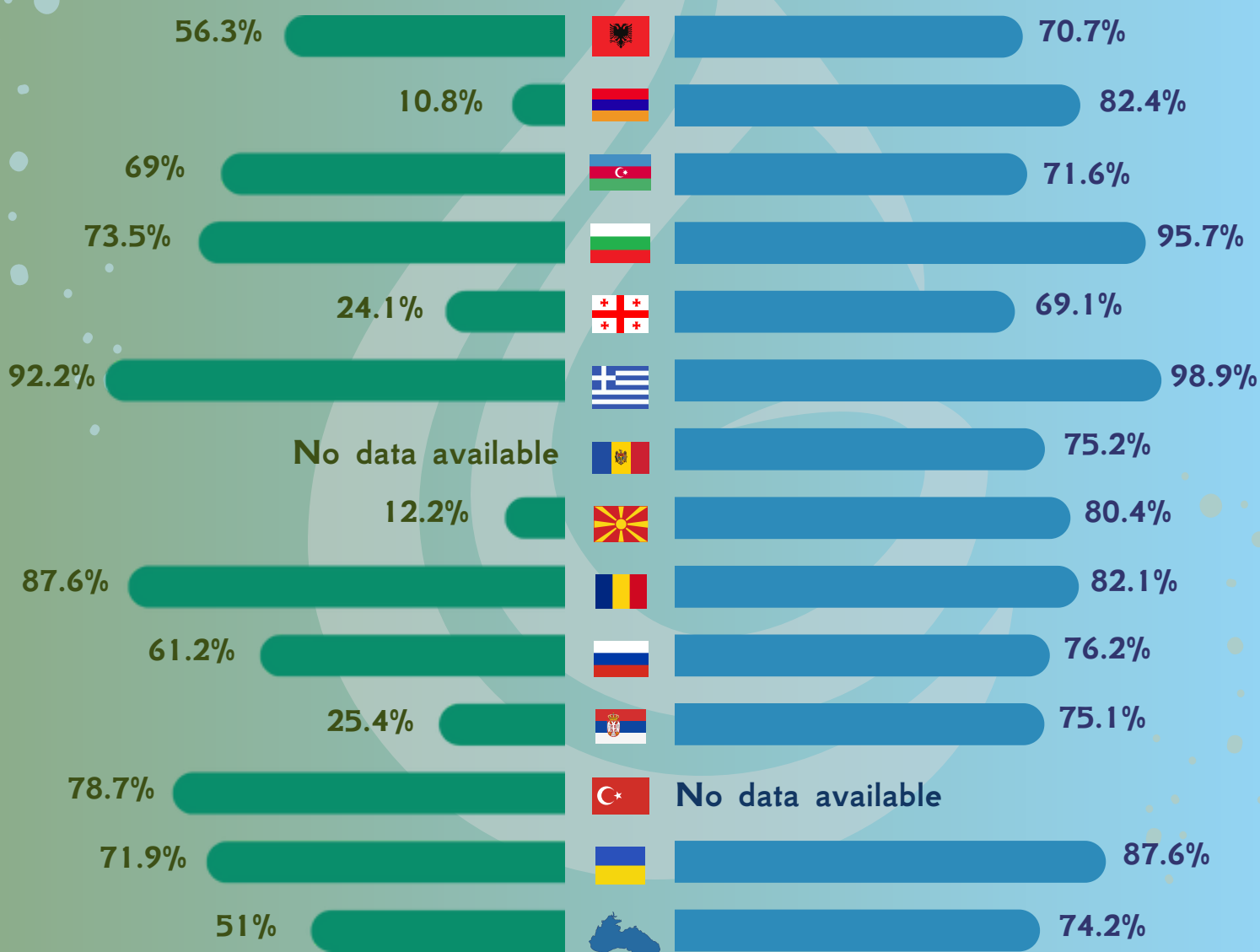


ELIMINATION OF WATER POLLUTION AND PROVISION OF ACCESS TO SANITATION & HYGIENE

The proportion of the population using a safely managed sanitation service; a basic facility that safely disposes of human waste.

ACCESS TO SAFE AND AFFORDABLE DRINKING WATER

The proportion of the population using a safely managed drinking water service; an improved source located on premises, available when needed and free from contamination.



With the exception of the Republic of Azerbaijan, for which the latest available data is from 2019, the graphs above are based on data from 2022.

OVER THE LAST TWO DECADES

Romania
The proportion of the population using a safely managed drinking water service increased:
from 40.4% in 2000 to 75.2% in 2022

The proportion of the population using a safely managed sanitation service increased:

Romania +40.7%

Turkey +35.5%

The proportion of the population using a safely managed sanitation service decreased:

Bulgaria -4%

Georgia -18.5%

Serbia -3.8%

The level of participation by users/communities that were involved in programs in water resources planning & management in 2022:
