Participation of ICBSS at MedCat Days 2024 "Tackling climate change in times of multiple crises in the Mediterranean. A challenge for the new European political cycle"

On 25 – 26 June 2024, the ICBSS participated at MedCat Days 2024, organised by the Government of Catalonia and the European Institute of the Mediterranean (IEMed), in Barcelona, Spain.

MedCat Days provide a space for meeting and dialogue, also for advocacy and visibility at the service of the actors of the wider region. With the title "Tackling climate change in times of multiple crises in the Mediterranean.
