

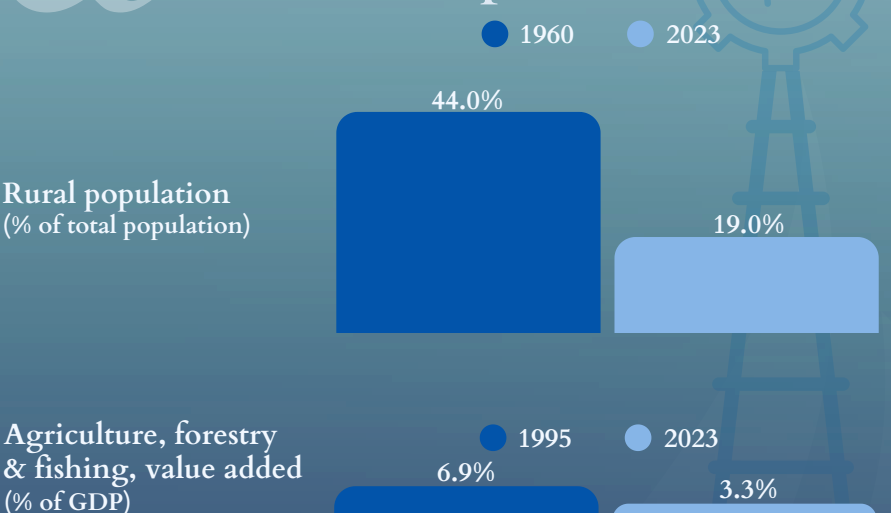

Athens, the country's largest city, has the 38.0% of the urban population.

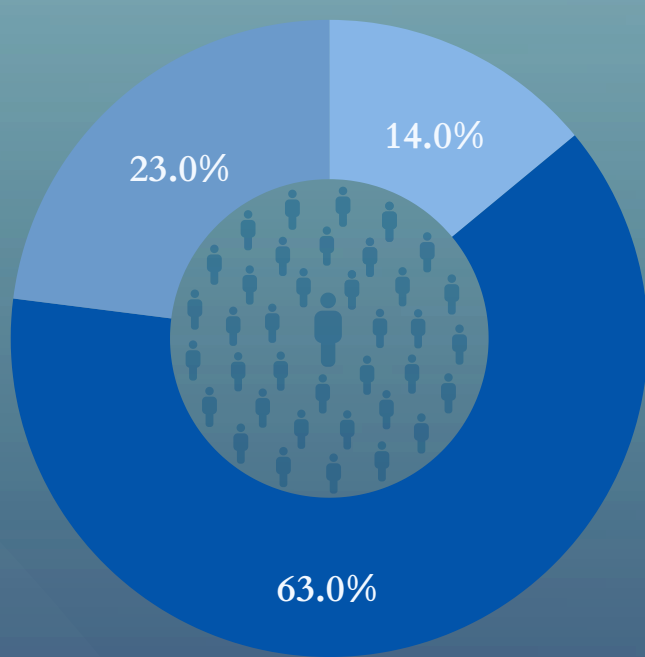

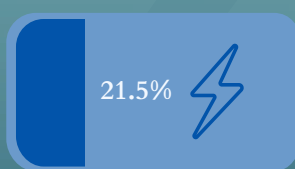

Terrestrial and marine protected areas (% of total territorial area in 2024)



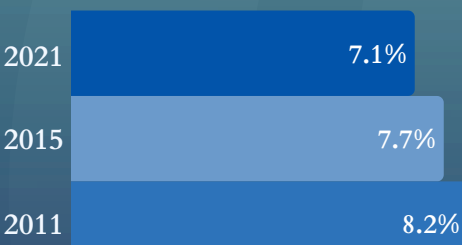
Gender Inequality Index (GII)

GII measures gender inequalities in reproductive health, empowerment & labour market.

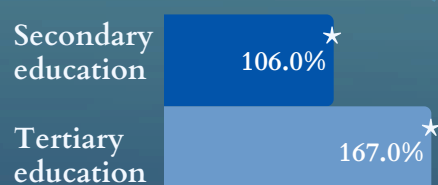

Government expenditure on education (% of government expenditure)



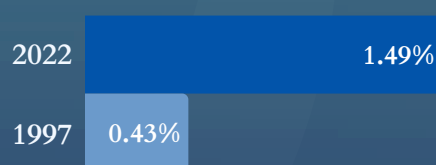
School Enrollment in 2022 (% gross)

Research & development expenditure (% of GDP)

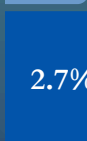

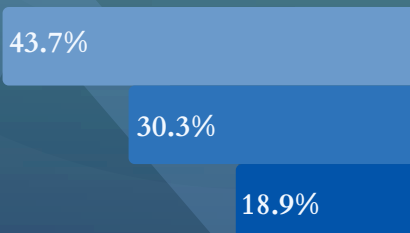
GDP growth (annual % in 2023)



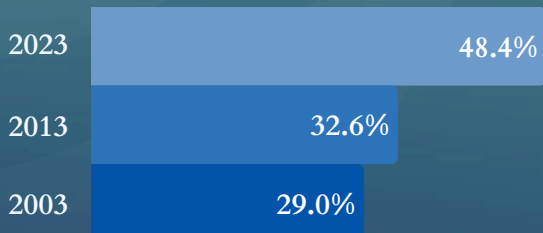
Inflation, consumer prices (annual % in 2024)



Exports of goods & services (% of GDP)

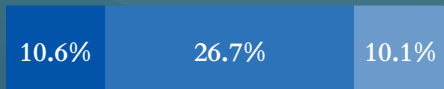


Imports of goods & services (% of GDP)

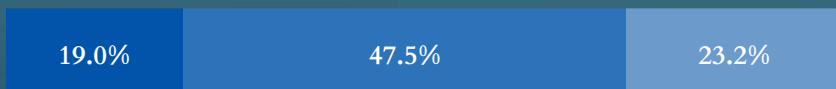

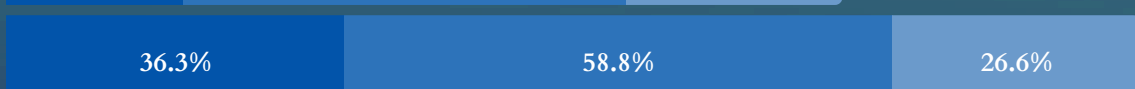
Total (% of total labor force)



Youth male (% of male labor force ages 15-24)

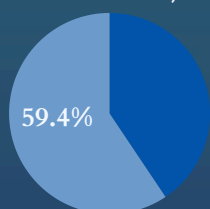


Youth female (% of female labor force ages 15-24)

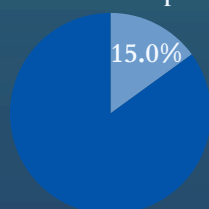
